### *Pre-Vision Therapy Experience:*

*Baylee struggles with a lazy eye. She has always done fairly well in school, except for reading and math. She would complain about not understanding what the concepts were for math and that she would have to read and re-read things all the time. Her memory of what she just read was somewhat poor. Although if she read it out loud, that would help her remember; utilizing several senses to understand. Learning to cope and "get by" was always a challenge. She felt she wasn't all that smart.*

### *Computerized Vision Therapy Experience:*

*The computerized program was very easy to use-although challenging to do for 5 minutes. She had a hard time staying focused on the screen for that long. We loved the fact that it was on the computer and not having a bunch of items to know how to use and when to flip, etc.*
